



BETA SOFTWARE POLICY

The Budapest Home Office strives to update the software of the SCIO, EDUCTOR and QUEST9 with an updated version of the software released every year. However, an updated version of the software requires strict control, testing, and documentation to ensure that the latest version of the software is stable and effective.

Therefore, we have established a testing procedure called “BETA Testing.” After changes to the software go through the “BETA Testing” procedure and are approved, then it is officially released by the Budapest Home Office. This is important for ensuring the stability and effectiveness of the software, maintaining compliance with the registrations, and allowing all Technical Support to offer the best service if you have difficulties with the software.

If you are using any version other than the one on the website www.scio-eductor.com, then you are using a version that is not officially approved and released.

To find out which is the current official software update that is approved and released, please visit the website of the Budapest Home Office www.scio-eductor.com and check under “Downloads/Softwares&tools”. This will tell you the current version as approved and released by the Budapest Home Office.

Please always keep in mind that the first contact for assistance in software and technical issues is to be the Support Staff of the Broker from whom you’ve purchased your device.

The goal of the Budapest Home Office is that there will be one (1) release of a software update every year.
